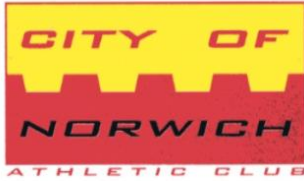

**THE OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT BURSARY AWARD SCHEME**

The scheme has been designed to recognize athletes who have attained a high level of performance achieved through training, dedication and commitment. The scheme will operate on a calendar year basis as follows:

Maximum award per calendar year for an athlete will be £150.

The applicant must be a First Claim and currently paid-up member of CoNAC.

The applicant must complete and sign the Bursary Application form when applying for an award.

The applicant must have represented CoNAC, in a Club team event and in Club colours, at least three times in the calendar year of application.

An athlete can receive one Power of 10 award in the calendar year and must apply using the Bursary Application form. The award will be based on the current year ranking list at 31 Oct.

Bursary Awards will be paid at the annual presentation evening.

Bursary Awards will also be paid to athletes in the disability categories using the criteria as for able bodied athletes.

**NOTES**

- Selection for GB: £150 (£50 if first national selection already achieved)
- Selection for England, Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland: £100
- Top three Power of 10 final ranking: 1st - £75, 2nd - £50 3rd - £30
